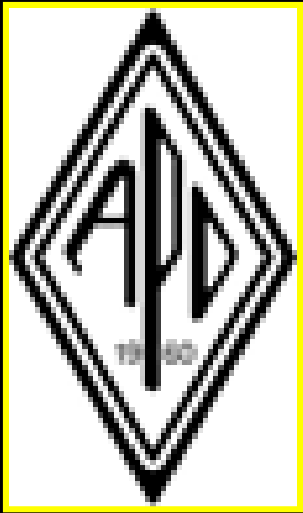

Association of Professors of Dermatology (Created by AAD Academic Leaders, 1960)

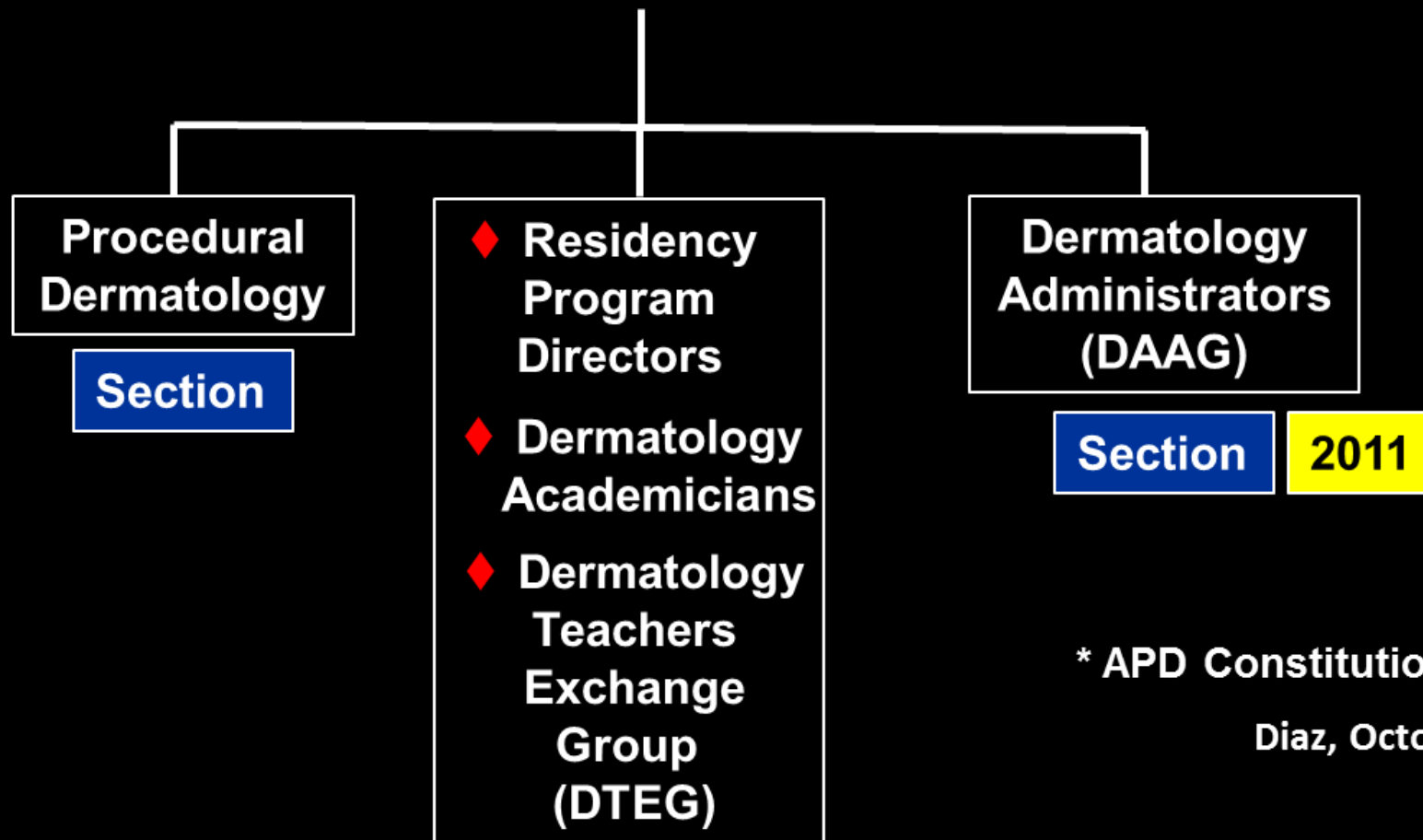

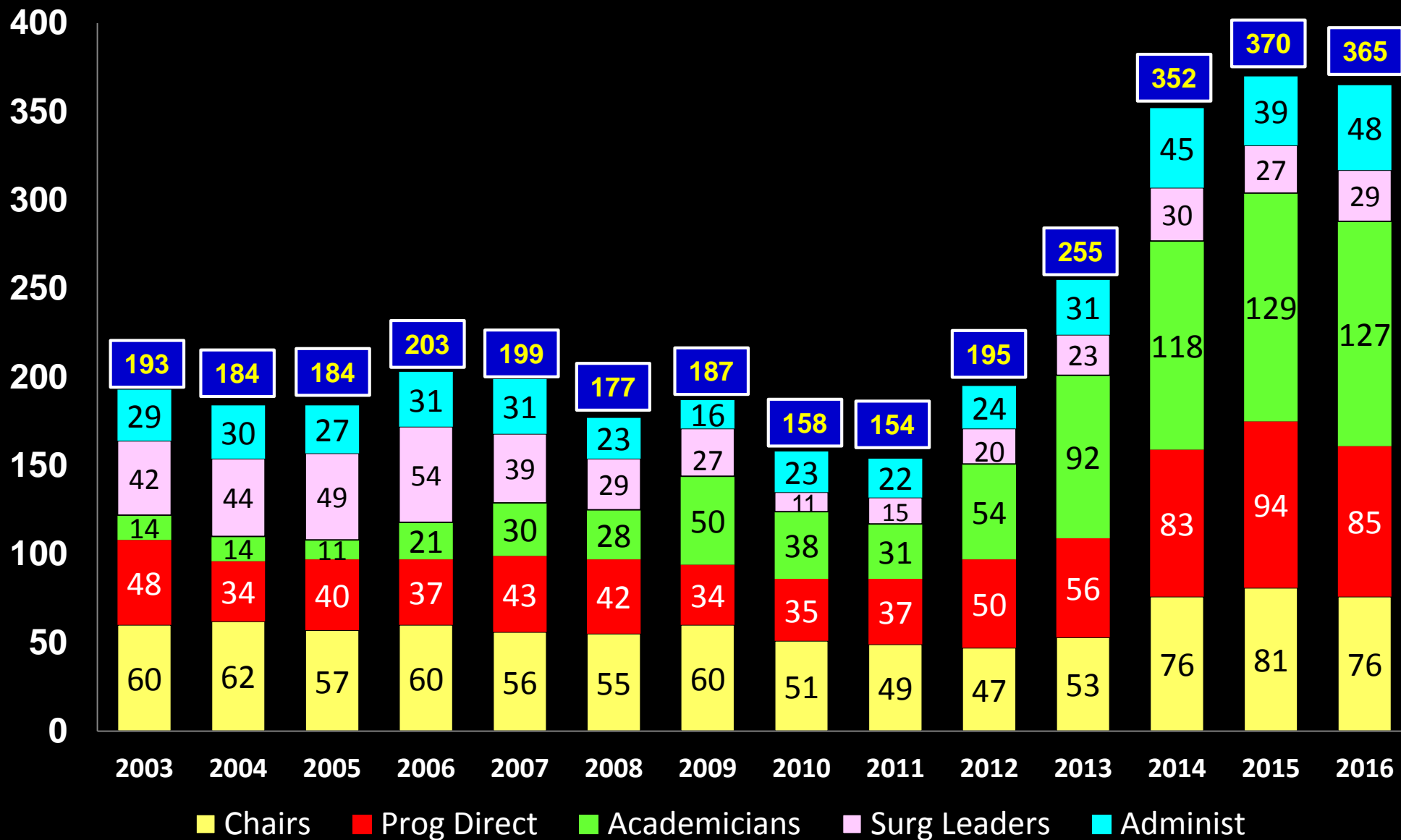

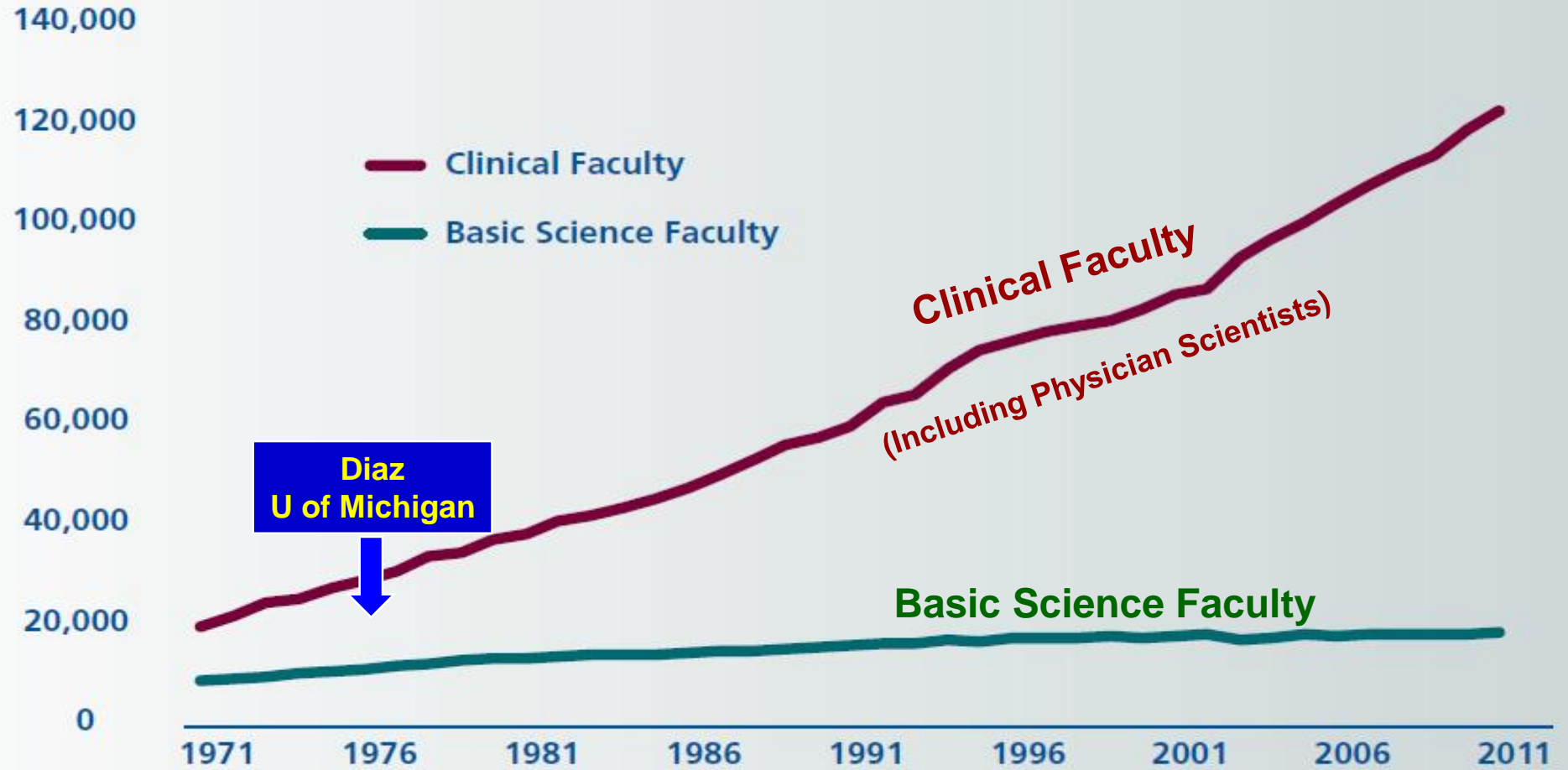

Number of Full-Time Faculty

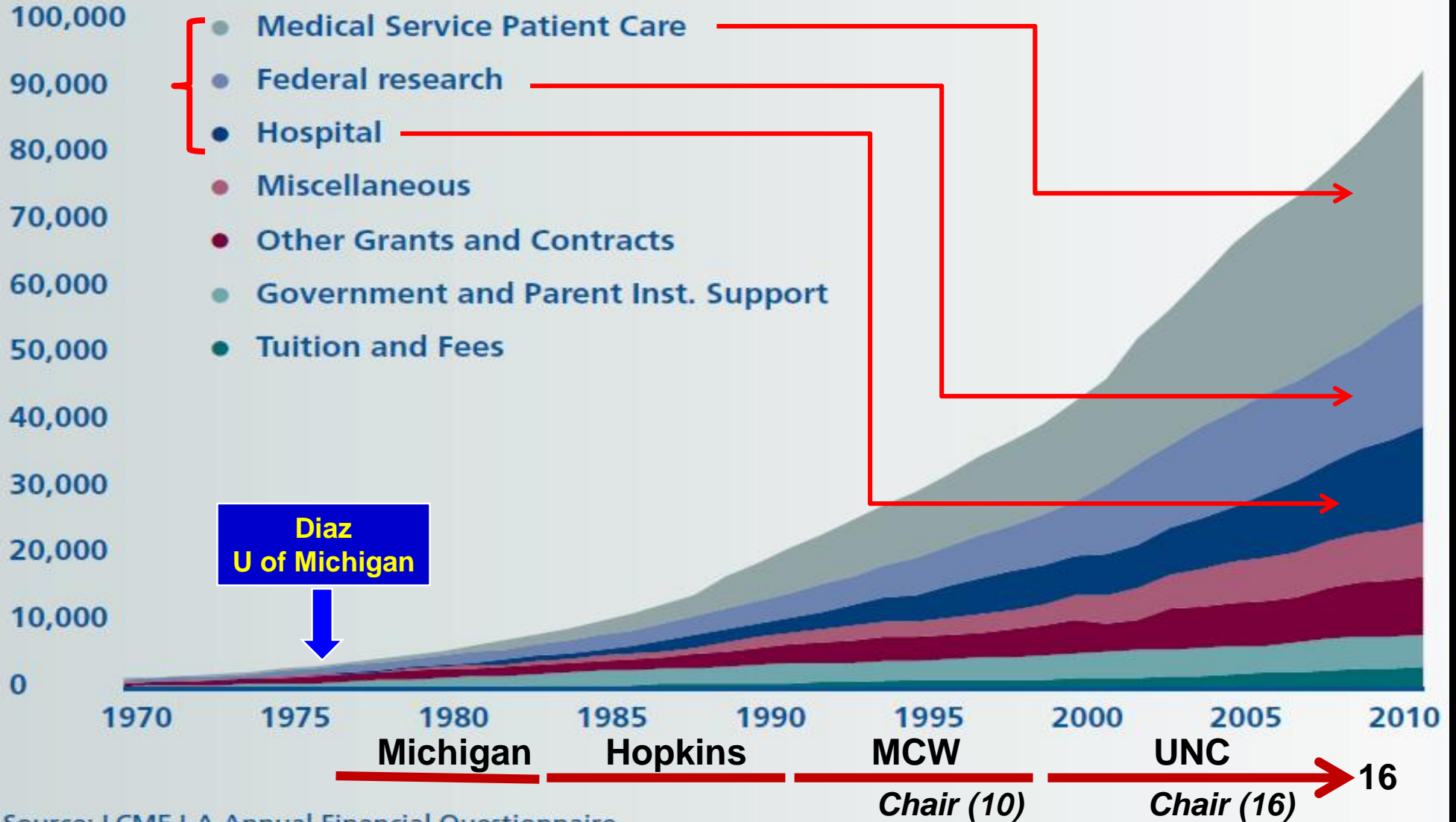

Challenges of US Schools of Medicine

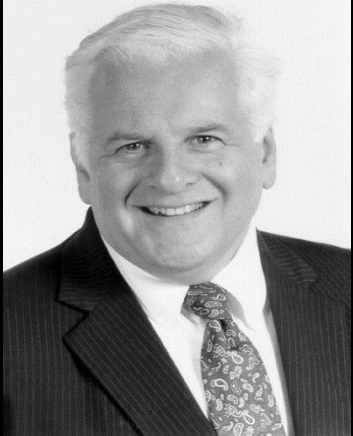
- ◆ **Clinical Practice is a business dependent on the health care industry rules**
- ◆ **Compensation of Clinical Faculty: cFTE, RVUs, benchmarks**
 - ✓ **Fixed salary: gone!**
 - ✓ **Salary + Productivity bonuses. Faculty lured to see more patients, hence less effort in education**
 - ✓ **Future metrics: tied to value-based vs fee for service?**
- ◆ **Taxation to Clinical Departments**
- ◆ **NIH-funded Research extremely competitive**
- ◆ **Education mission poorly funded**
