The Dermatology Teachers Exchange Group (DTEG) will meet **4:15-6:30 pm on Friday September 25, 2009**, the afternoon before the annual meeting of the Association of Professors of Dermatology (APD) in Chicago, Illinois.

As usual, we welcome presentations on innovative teaching and provocative issues in education. For this meeting, however, priority will be given to the specific theme of "Managing the Problem Resident".

Abstracts must be 2500 characters or less, including spaces (font size 12). Begin with the title, authors' full names, institutions' full name, and geographic location. **For submissions on "Managing the Problem Resident", prospective or retrospective studies are preferred, although single case reports are acceptable if such are formatted to answer the following issues:**

- 1. What ACGME competency was involved (patient care, medical knowledge, professionalism, communication & interpersonal skills, practice-based learning, systems-based practice)?**
- 2. Describe the problem succinctly.**
- 3. Was the conflict resolved, and if so how was it resolved?**
- 4. What lessons were learned?**
