Dr. Cohen is President Emeritus of the Association of American Medical Colleges (AAMC), as such he has led AAMC that supports the nation's medical schools and teaching hospitals.

His almost 40-year career in academic medicine has included positions at some of the most prestigious institutions in the country. Most recently, he served as Dean of the medical school and Professor of Medicine at the State University of New York at Stony Brook, and President of the medical staff at University Hospital.

Prior to serving as Dean at SUNY-Stony Brook, Dr. Cohen served as Professor

and Associate Chairman of Medicine at the University of Chicago-Pritzker School of Medicine, and Physician-in-Chief and Chairman of the Department of Medicine at the Michael Reese Hospital and Medical Center.

He has held a wide variety of leadership positions in almost all aspects of academic medicine, including chair of the American Board of Internal Medicine and the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education, as well as president of the Association of Program Directors of Internal Medicine.


SELECTION PROCESS

a proven record related to the scope of the lecture evidenced by written scholarship and documented accomplishments, including implementing innovative ideas. The lecturer need not be a dermatologist. International candidates (non-US/Canada) can be considered.

LECTURESHIP INFORMATION

The Lowell Goldsmith Lecture is delivered at the annual meeting of the APD. It is accompanied by a certificate and honorarium. Travel expenses conforming to APD guidelines will also be covered for lecturers who are not APD members. No more than one lecturer is selected annually, but there is no requirement that the lectureship occur each year. There are no restrictions as to the type of degree or the lecturer's area of expertise.


