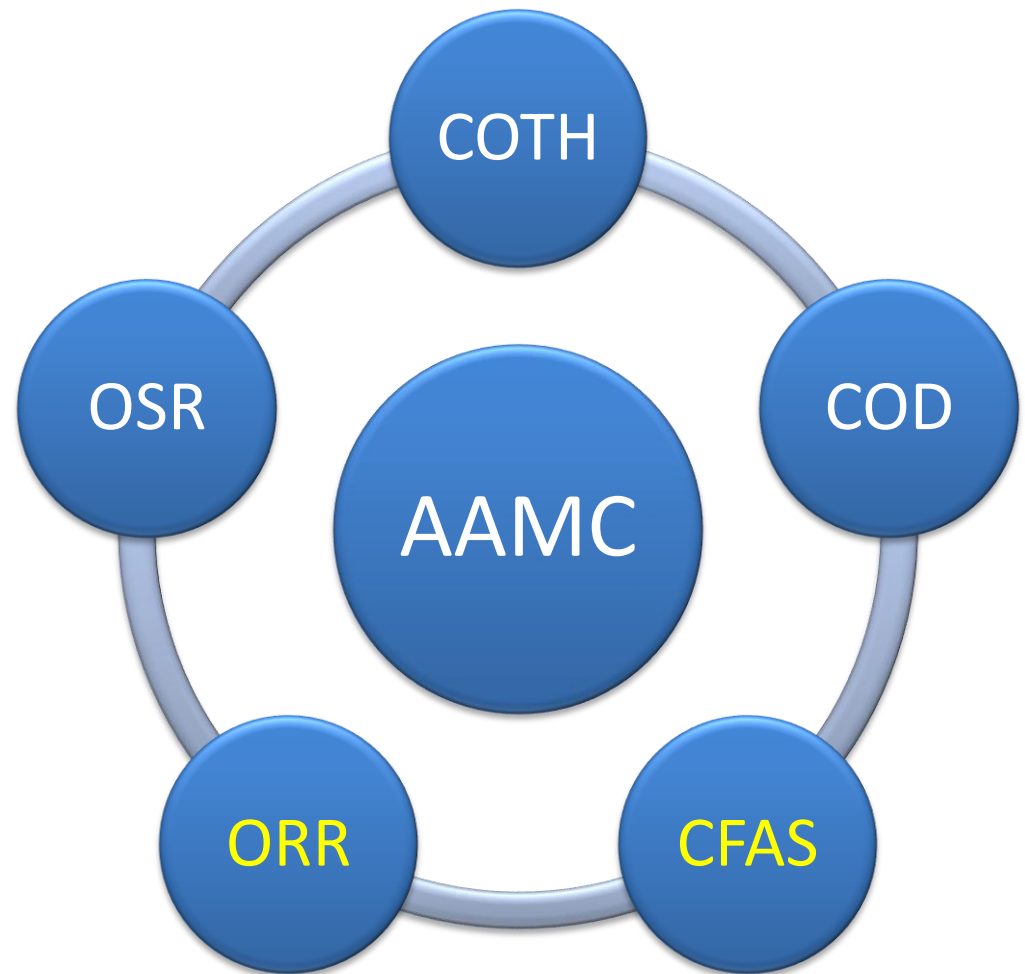
APD Business Meeting

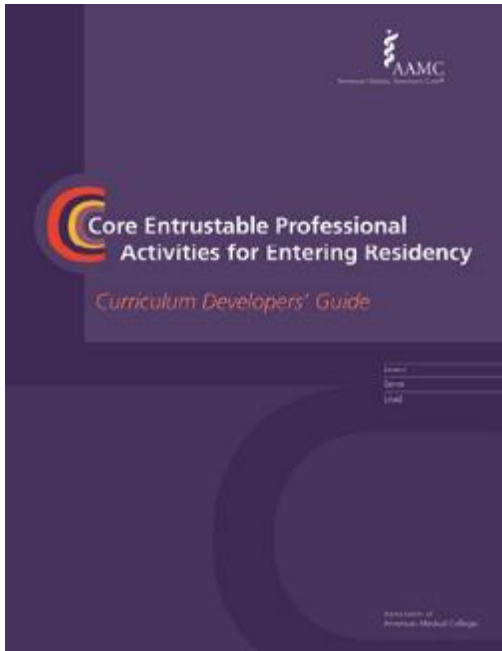

Ensuring graduating students enter residency with a full complement of skills needed to be functional residents



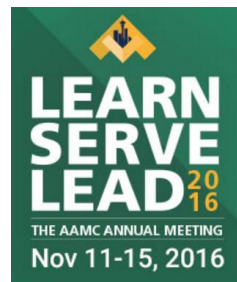
Exploring time-variable and competency-based residency training and advancement
