The **Dermatology Teachers Exchange Group (DTEG)** will meet **Friday, September 19th** from 4:30 – 6:00 pm at The Omni Hotel, Fort Worth, Texas, during the annual meeting of the Association of Professors of Dermatology.

The DTEG meeting focuses on excellent data-driven abstract submissions stemming from all areas pertinent to dermatology education. Abstracts must include the title, authors' full names, institutions' full name(s), and geographic location. Abstracts must be 2000 characters or less, including spaces (font size 12). Submission deadline is **Tuesday, July 1st** (Submissions must include contact person, phone number, and email addresses). SPECIAL THEME:

Abstracts from **any aspect of dermatology education** are welcome. Each year we try to highlight a special education theme portion of the meeting. This year, the special theme sought for presentations will be “Enhancing Clinical Learning and Assessment in the 4th year Dermatology Rotation.”

The special theme relates to how we engage 4th year medical students during clinical dermatology rotations. This can include:

- Medical student- specific didactics or procedural training
- Clinical performance or medical knowledge assessments
- Feedback methods
- Assessment of readiness for residency

Please submit an abstract if you have information to share regarding this special theme.

Selection for presentation is competitive, with approximately 30% of submissions selected for eventual presentation. Submitted abstracts are scored by a panel of judges, rated on 4 factors: data driven nature of project, appropriateness for the DTEG audience, interest to dermatology teachers, and pertinence to the special theme.

Presentations are SHORT, typically around 5 minutes depending on the number of selected abstracts. Group Discussion also occurs throughout the evening.
